Location: *Our Mother's Attic* is located on Main Street (US Route 301) in downtown Wildwood, a block south of City Hall on the west side of the street.

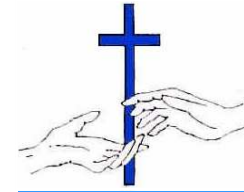
